Privacy statement

Disclosure of Personal information to unrelated third parties . Both MSLA International and its affiliates share personal information collected through the following means:

Where appropriate, before disclosing any personal information to a third party, MSLA International will require by contract that the third take all proper precautions to protect data from unauthorized disclosure or any use.

Integrity and information security . MSLA International will take reasonable commercial measures to safeguard the reliability, accuracy, integrity and update the information in our databases and to protect the safety of them. We keep personal information for as long as reasonably required in accordance with the purposes for which it was collected or to comply with a legal report required or any requirements for document retention.
